- Owners are responsible for arranging emergency veterinary care.
- Aggression or bite incidents will result in the session ending for safety.
- Unsafe environments or welfare concerns may lead to postponement.
- No choke, prong, or shock collars are permitted.
- Outdoor sessions may be adjusted due to severe weather.
- Owners must disclose medical or behavioural history before training.
- Tiny Tails reserves the right to refuse services if safety cannot be maintained.
